Young Adult Fellowship-

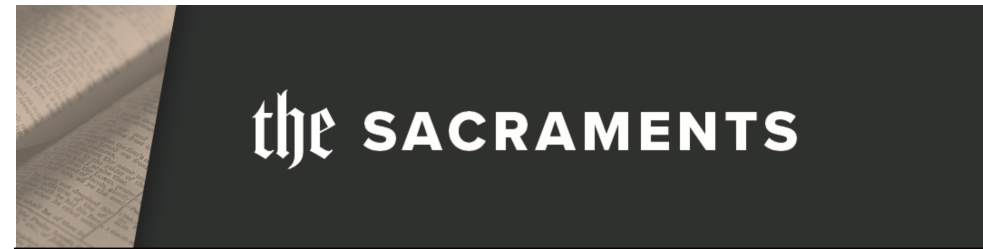
