When an athlete gets out of practice at 6:30 and has to choose between Bible study or going to get food, food wins every time. Athletes will show up to our meetings when we offer the physical fuel they need, and they will walk out with the spiritual fuel they needed even more. We feed athletes 12 months a year, and all of it depends on the donations of ministry partners like you. When someone gives a special, onetime gift, it helps a lot! Kairos Prison Ministries Southeastern Correctional Institution

Thank all of you for your support. We had plenty of cookies, posters, food, and above all, prayer chain. We took into prison over 2,000 dozen cookies; we reached our goal of \$7,000 which covered meals and other Kairos expenses. For me, and many others, the prayer chain is the highlight of proving there is a real, tangible family of God that has not forgotten them and is actively praying for them at that very moment. Our prayer chain reached around the chapel two full times. Many at my table were surprised and impressed by this.

Once again, the prison sent us the gang leaders, hard heads, and trouble makers. At least two, if not three, of these were at my table: one white member of a motorcycle club (a club everyone has heard of) and two black gang members. These are traditionally mortal enemies! By the end of the weekend, they found something in common: the love of God and a true brotherhood of the family of God. There is a favorite song at Kairos. The chorus says, "I ain't gonna study war no more." By the end of the weekend, I stood between them, arm in arm, as we agreed we ain't gonna make war no more!!"
